

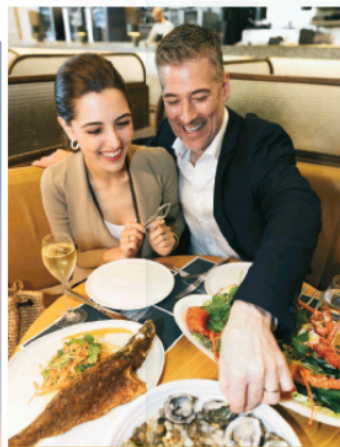
EAT, STAY & PLAY IN ADELAIDE

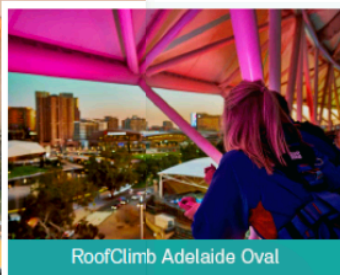

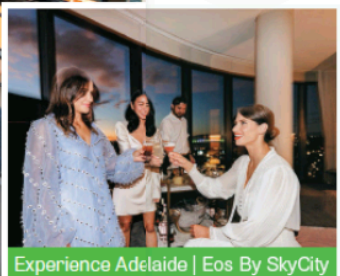
